AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2650
AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 2650 on page 3,
below line 8, by inserting the following:
"Section 10. The Automated Traffic Control Systems in
Highway Construction or Maintenance Zones Act is amended by
changing Sections 10 and 30 as follows:
(625 ILCS 7/10)
Sec. 10. Establishment of automated control systems. The
Department of State Police may establish an automated traffic
control system in any construction or maintenance zone
established by the Department of Transportation or the Illinois
State Toll Highway Authority. An automated traffic control
system may operate only during those periods when workers are
present in the construction or maintenance zone. In any
prosecution based upon evidence obtained through an automated
traffic control system established under this Act, the State
must prove that one or more workers were present in the
construction or maintenance zone when the violation occurred.

20 (625 ILCS 7/30)

21 Sec. 30. Requirements for issuance of a citation.

(a) The vehicle, vehicle operator, vehicle registrationplate, speed, date, time, and location must be clearly visible

on the photograph or other recorded image of the alleged
violation.

3 (b) A Uniform Traffic Citation must be mailed or otherwise 4 delivered to the registered owner of the vehicle. If mailed, 5 the citation must be sent via certified mail within <u>14</u> 6 6 business days of the alleged violation, return receipt 7 requested.

(c) The Uniform Traffic Citation must include:

(1) the name and address of the vehicle owner;

(2) the registration number of the vehicle;

(3) the offense charged;

12 (4) the time, date, and location of the violation;

(5) the first available court date; and

14 (6) notice that the basis of the citation is the 15 photograph or recorded image from the automated traffic 16 control system.

(d) The Uniform Traffic Citation issued to the violator must be accompanied by a written document that lists the violator's rights and obligations and explains how the violator can elect to proceed by either paying the fine or challenging the issuance of the Uniform Traffic Citation.
