AN ACT concerning law enforcement.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Police Training Act is amended by 5 changing Section 10 as follows:

6 (50 ILCS 705/10) (from Ch. 85, par. 510)

7 Sec. 10. The Board may make, amend and rescind such rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the provisions 8 9 this Act, including those relating to the annual of certification of retired law enforcement officers qualified 10 under federal law to carry a concealed weapon, except that the 11 fee for annual certification of such retired officers shall not 12 exceed \$5. A copy of all rules and regulations and amendments 13 14 or rescissions thereof shall be filed with the Secretary of State within a reasonable time after their adoption. The 15 16 schools certified by the Board and participating in the 17 training program may dismiss from the school any trainee prior to his completion of the course, if in the opinion of the 18 19 person in charge of the training school, the trainee is unable or unwilling to satisfactorily complete the prescribed course 20 21 of training.
