2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Hearing Instrument Consumer Protection Act
is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2016)

Sec. 1. Purpose. The The purpose of this Act is to protect 8 9 the hearing-impaired public from incompetent and dishonest 10 dispensers of hearing instruments who could endanger the health, safety and welfare of the People of this State. The 11 Federal Food and Drug Administration has recommended that State 12 legislation is necessary in order to establish standards of 13 14 competency and to impose stringent penalties for those who violate the public trust in this field of health care. 15
