18	amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS
19	Federal Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State
20	for the payment of any operational expenses relating to the
21	cost incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor
22	Vehicle safety program by assuring and verifying the identity
23	of drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for
24	improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal

- 1 Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed
- 2 appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.
- 3 Section 150. The amount of \$925,000, or so much of this
- 4 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
- 5 the Secretary of State from the Securities Investors
- 6 Education Fund for any expenses used to promote public
- 7 awareness of the dangers of securities fraud.
- 8 Section 155. The amount of \$2,500, or so much of this
- 9 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
- 10 the Secretary of State from the Secretary of State Evidence
- 11 Fund for the purchase of evidence, for the employment of
- 12 persons to obtain evidence, and for the payment for any goods
- or services related to obtaining evidence.
- 14 Section 160. The amount of \$110,000, or so much thereof
- as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Alternate Fuels
- 16 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of
- 17 administering the Alternate Fuels Act.
- 18 Section 165. The amount of \$6,687,000, or so much of this
- 19 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
- 20 Secretary of State Special Services Fund to the Office of the
- 21 Secretary of State for office automation and technology.

- Section 170. The amount of \$7,000,000, or so much of this
- 2 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Motor
- 3 Vehicle License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
- 4 State for the cost incident to providing new or replacement
- 5 plates for motor vehicles.
- 6 Section 175. The sum of \$900,000, or so much of this
- 7 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the
- 8 Secretary of State DUI Administration Fund to the Office of
- 9 Secretary of State for operation of the Department of
- 10 Administrative Hearings of the Office of Secretary of State
- 11 and for no other purpose.
- 12 Section 180. The amount of \$15,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
- 14 Police DUI Fund to the Secretary of State for the purchase of
- 15 law enforcement equipment to assist in the prevention of
- 16 alcohol-related criminal violence throughout the State.
- 17 Section 185. The amount of \$35,000 is appropriated from
- 18 the Secretary of State Police Services Fund to the Secretary
- 19 of State for purposes as indicated by the grantor or
- 20 contractor or, in the case of money bequeathed or granted for
- 21 no specific purpose, for any purpose as deemed appropriate by

- the Director of Police, Secretary of State in administering 1
- 2 the responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of
- Police. 3
- Section 200. The following amount, or so much of this 4
- 5 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of
- the Secretary of State for any operations, alterations, 6
- rehabilitation, new construction, and maintenance of the 7
- interior and exterior of the various buildings and facilities 8
- 9 under the jurisdiction of the Secretary of State to enhance
- 10 security measures in the Capitol Complex:
- From the General Revenue Fund300,000 11
- The sum of \$500,000, or so much of this 12 Section 225.
- amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent 13
- 14 BAIID Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to
- 15 reimburse ignition interlock device providers per Public Act
- 16 95-0400.
- Section 230. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of this 17
- amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from 18
- Franchise Tax and License Fee Amnesty Administration Fund to 19
- the Office of the Secretary of State for any Secretary of 20
- 21 State costs associated with the administration of the
- 22 Franchise Tax and License Fee Amnesty Act of 2007.
