SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/11-6.5 720 ILCS 5/11-6.6 new

Amends the Criminal Code of 1961. Creates the offense of indecent solicitation of a parent, legal guardian, or custodian of a person under 17 years of age. Provides that the offense is committed if the person knowingly uses a computer on-line service, Internet service, local bulletin board service, or any other device capable of electronic data storage or transmission to solicit, lure, or entice, or attempt to solicit, lure, or entice a parent, legal guardian, or custodian of a person under 17 years of age or a person believed to be a parent, legal guardian, or custodian of a person under 17 years of age to consent to the participation of such person under 17 years of age in any act of sexual penetration or sexual conduct with a person 17 years of age or over.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Criminal Code of 1961 is amended by changing

 Section 11-6.5 and by adding Section 11-6.6 as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/11-6.5)
- 7 Sec. 11-6.5. Indecent solicitation of an adult.
- 8 (a) Except as otherwise provided in Section 11-6.6, a A
 9 person commits indecent solicitation of an adult if the person:
- 10 (1) Arranges for a person 17 years of age or over to 11 commit an act of sexual penetration as defined in Section 12 12-12 with a person:
- 13 (i) Under the age of 13 years; or
- 14 (ii) Thirteen years of age or over but under the 15 age of 17 years; or
- 16 (2) Arranges for a person 17 years of age or over to
 17 commit an act of sexual conduct as defined in Section 12-12
 18 with a person:
 - (i) Under the age of 13 years; or
- 20 (ii) Thirteen years of age or older but under the 21 age of 17 years.
