HB6164 -5- OMB095 00273 KML 20273 b Section 30. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants available for the development of new fire districts.

5 Section 35. The sum of \$522,500, or so much thereof as 6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground 7 Storage Tank Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for 8 a grant to the City of Chicago for Administrative Costs 9 incurred as a result of the State's Underground Storage 10 Program.

11 Section 40. The sum of \$498,500, or so much thereof as 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention 13 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants 14 available for the development of local government fire 15 prevention.

16 Section 45. The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention 18 Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants 19 available for costs and services related to ILEAS/MABAS 20 administration.

21 Section 50. The sum of \$342,346, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of 2 business on June 30, 2008, from an appropriation heretofore 3 made for such purpose in Article 380, Section 55 of Public 4 Act 95-348, is reappropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund 5 to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for equipment 6 purchases.

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Section 55. The sum of \$675,000, or so much thereof as
may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for grants
available for the NITE project.

11 Section 60. The sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may 12 be necessary, is appropriated from the Cigarette Fire Safety 13 Standard Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for the 14 purpose of fire safety and prevention programs.

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Section 65. The sum of \$780,900, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund to the Office of the State Fire Marshal for costs and expenses related to or in support of a public safety shared services center.

Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July1, 2008.
