1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
7 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
8 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to
9 the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission:

4 Section 10. The amount of \$118,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
6 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the
7 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission for printing and
8 distribution of Workers' Compensation handbooks containing
9 information as to the rights and obligations of employers.

10 Section 15. The amount of \$255,000, or so much thereof
11 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
12 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the
13 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission for the
14 implementation and operation of an accident reporting system.

15 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much
16 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects
17 and purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated from the
18 Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to
19 the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission:

11 Section 25. The amount of \$1,150,000, or so much thereof
 12 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
 13 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois
 14 Workers' Compensation Commission for costs associated with
 15 the establishment, administration and operations of the
 16 Insurance Compliance Division of the workers' compensation
 17 anti-fraud program administered by Illinois Workers'
 18 Compensation Commission.

19 Section 30. The amount of \$225,000, or so much thereof
 20 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois
 21 Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois
 22 Workers' Compensation Commission for costs associated with
 23 the establishment of the Medical Fee Schedule and other

1 provisions of the Workers' Compensation Act.

2 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
3 1, 2008.
