1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 6418

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 6418, by deleting  
3 everything after the enacting clause and inserting in lieu  
4 thereof the following:

5 "ARTICLE 1

6 Section 5. The sum of \$74,000, or so much thereof as may  
7 be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility  
8 Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce  
9 Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call Notice  
10 System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility  
11 Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

12 Section 10. The sum of \$45,900,000, or so much thereof  
13 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless

1 Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission  
2 for grants to emergency telephone system boards, qualified  
3 government entities, or the Department of State Police for  
4 the design, implementation, operation, maintenance, or  
5 upgrade of wireless 9-1-1 or E9-1-1 emergency services and  
6 public safety answering points.

7 Section 15. The sum of \$12,500,000, or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless  
9 Carrier Reimbursement Fund to the Illinois Commerce  
10 Commission for reimbursement of wireless carriers for costs  
11 incurred in complying with the applicable provisions of  
12 Federal Communications Commission wireless enhanced 9-1-1  
13 services mandates and for administrative costs incurred by  
14 the Illinois Commerce Commission related to administering the  
15 program.

16 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as  
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Digital Divide  
18 Elimination Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois Commerce  
19 Commission for grants and awards for the construction of  
20 high-speed data transmission facilities.

21 Section 25. The amount of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof  
22 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of

1 business on June 30, 2008, from an appropriation heretofore  
2 made for such purpose in Article 195, Section 40 of Public  
3 Act 95-348, is reappropriated from the Digital Divide  
4 Elimination Infrastructure Fund to the Illinois Commerce  
5 Commission for grants and awards for the construction of  
6 high-speed data transmission facilities.

7 Section 30. The sum of \$7,000,000, or so much thereof as  
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation  
9 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1)  
10 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance  
11 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration  
12 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for  
13 administrative expenses.

14 Section 35. The sum of \$1,300,000, or so much thereof as  
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation  
16 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for the  
17 costs associated with the implementation of Senate Bill 435,  
18 the Illinois Commercial Safety Towing Law. This section is  
19 operative only if Senate Bill 435 of the 95<sup>th</sup> General Assembly  
20 becomes law.

21 Section 40. The sum of \$170,000, or so much thereof as  
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue

1 Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for railroad safety  
2 and inspection.

3 ARTICLE 999

4 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect  
5 July 1, 2008."
