

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 10. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as  
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
7 Fund to the Department of Public Health for expenses targeted  
8 to decrease health disparities in communities of color for  
9 Breast and Cervical Cancer.

10 Section 11. The sum of \$2,750,000, or so much thereof as  
11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue  
12 Fund to the Department of Public Health for distribution of  
13 medical education scholarships authorized by An Act to  
14 provide grants for family practice residency programs and  
15 medical student scholarships through the Illinois Department  
16 of Public Health.

17 Section 15. The following named amount, or so much  
18 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated to the  
19 Department of Public Health from the Public Health Services  
20 Fund for the objects and purposes hereinafter named:
