Amends the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning grievance procedures.

1 AN ACT concerning government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Public Labor Relations Act is amended by changing Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 315/8) (from Ch. 48, par. 1608)
- 7 Sec. 8. Grievance Procedure. The The collective bargaining 8 agreement negotiated between the employer and the exclusive 9 representative shall contain a grievance resolution procedure 10 which shall apply to all employees in the bargaining unit and shall provide for final and binding arbitration of disputes 11 concerning the administration or interpretation 12 13 agreement unless mutually agreed otherwise. Any agreement 14 containing a final and binding arbitration provision shall also contain a provision prohibiting strikes for the duration of the 15 agreement. The grievance and arbitration provisions of any 16 17 collective bargaining agreement shall be subject to Illinois "Uniform Arbitration Act". The costs of 18 19 arbitration shall be borne equally by the employer and the 20 employee organization.
