2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Dental Practice Act is amended by 5 changing Section 8.1 as follows:

6 (225 ILCS 25/8.1) (from Ch. 111, par. 2308.1)

Sec. 8.1. No licensed dentist shall administer general 8 9 anesthesia or conscious sedation without first applying for and and obtaining a permit for such purpose from the Department. 10 The Department shall issue such permit only after ascertaining 11 applicant possesses the minimum qualifications 12 the that necessary to protect public safety. A person with a dental 13 14 degree who administers anesthesia or conscious sedation in an approved hospital training program under the supervision of 15 16 either a licensed dentist holding such permit or a physician 17 licensed to practice medicine in all its branches shall not be required to obtain such permit. 18
