SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 106/7 new
215 ILCS 170/7 new
305 ILCS 5/1-12 new

Amends the Children's Health Insurance Program Act, the Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act, and the Illinois Public Aid Code. Provides that notwithstanding any other provision of any of those Acts, no program or eligibility group may be added or expanded under any of those Acts without authorization by the 95th General Assembly. Provides that these provisions are repealed upon the sine die adjournment of the 95th General Assembly. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Children's Health Insurance Program Act is
5 amended by adding Section 7 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 106/7 new)

7 Sec. 7. No eligibility groups added or expanded.
8 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act to the
9 contrary, no eligibility group may be added or expanded under
10 this Act without authorization by the 95th General Assembly.
11 This Section is repealed upon the sine die adjournment of the
12 95th General Assembly.

13 Section 10. The Covering ALL KIDS Health Insurance Act is
14 amended by adding Section 7 as follows:

15 (215 ILCS 170/7 new)

16 Sec. 7. No eligibility groups added or expanded.
17 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Act to the
18 contrary, no eligibility group may be added or expanded under
19 this Act without authorization by the 95th General Assembly.
20 This Section is repealed upon the sine die adjournment of the
21 95th General Assembly.

1 Section 15. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
2 adding Section 1-12 as follows:

3 (305 ILCS 5/1-12 new)

4 Sec. 1-12. No programs or eligibility groups added or
5 expanded. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code to
6 the contrary, no program or eligibility group may be added or
7 expanded under this Code without authorization by the 95th
8 General Assembly. This Section is repealed upon the sine die
9 adjournment of the 95th General Assembly.

10 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
11 becoming law.
