13 WHEREAS, She moved to Chicago in the early 1940s and 14 married Willie Maurice Dew on December 27, 1952; she was 15 employed with the Cook County Hospital, St. Malachy Church, the 16 United States Post Office, Mile Square Health Center, and Rush 17 University Medical Center; she also performed domestic work and 18 private duty home health nursing after retirement; and
