1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4124

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4124 on page 5, by
3 replacing lines 21 through 24 with the following:

4 "and the production of documentary evidence, physical
5 evidence, electronic evidence, or other evidence relating to
6 any matter under investigation or hearing. If the release of
7 such evidence in an electronic format would create a risk of
8 harm to a third party, the responding entity shall submit that
9 evidence in an alternative format and shall redact all
10 information necessary to protect the identity and safety of the
11 third party. The Chairman of the Board may sign"; and

12 on page 6, by replacing lines 3 through 5 with the following:
13 "production of documentary evidence, physical evidence,
14 electronic evidence, or other evidence, may be required from
15 any"; and

16 on page 6, line 8 by inserting after "Board." the following:

1 "If the release of such evidence in an electronic format would
2 create a risk of harm to a third party, the responding entity
3 shall submit that evidence in an alternative format and shall
4 redact all information necessary to protect the identity and
5 safety of the third party."; and

6 on page 6, by replacing lines 19 through 21 with the following:
7 "documentary evidence, physical evidence, electronic evidence,
8 or any other evidence ~~or both~~. If the release of such evidence
9 in an electronic format would create a risk of harm to a third
10 party, the responding entity shall submit that evidence in an
11 alternative format and shall redact all information necessary
12 to protect the identity and safety of the third party. A copy
13 of such petition shall be served by"; and

14 on page 7, by replacing line 9 with the following:
15 "evidence, physical evidence, electronic evidence, or other
16 evidence if so ordered, or to give"; and

17 on page 7, line 11 by inserting after "hearing." the following:
18 "If the release of such evidence in an electronic format would
19 create a risk of harm to a third party, the responding entity
20 shall submit that evidence in an alternative format and shall
21 redact all information necessary to protect the identity and
22 safety of the third party.".
