1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 124

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 124, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment
4 No. 1, by inserting immediately before line 5 of page 1 the
5 following:

6 "ARTICLE 0.5

7 Section 5. "AN ACT making appropriations", Public Act
8 96-956, approved July 1, 2010, as amended, is amended by
9 adding Sections 30, 35, and 40 to Article 35 as follows:

10 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 35, Sec. 30 new)

11 Sec. 30. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
13 Fund to the Court of Claims for payment of awards solely as a

1 result of the lapsing of an appropriation originally made
2 from any funds held by the State Treasurer.

3 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 35, Sec. 35 new)

4 Sec. 35. The sum of \$14,000,000, or so much thereof as
5 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Court of Claims for payment of line of duty
7 awards.

8 (P.A. 96-956, Art. 35, Sec. 40 new)

9 Sec. 40. The following named amount, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Court of Claims
11 for payment of claims as follows:

12 For claims other than Crime Victims:

13 Payable from the General

14 Revenue Fund10,000,000"; and

15 on page 62, line 19 by changing "1,001,601" to "1,173,800";
16 and

17 on page 63, line 1 by changing "40,065" to "47,000"; and

18 on page 63, line 3 by changing "76,622" to "90,100"; and

19 on page 63, line 13 by changing "1,205,468" to "1,398,080";

1 and

2 by replacing lines 3 through 11 on page 64 with the
3 following:

4 "Section 20. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
6 appropriation hereto made for such purpose in Section 30 of
7 Article 35 of Public Act 96-956, as amended, is re-
8 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Court of
9 Claims for payment of awards solely as a result of the
10 lapsing of an appropriation originally made from any funds
11 held by the State Treasurer.

12 Section 25. The sum of \$14,000,000, or so much thereof
13 as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
14 appropriation hereto made for such purpose in Section 35 of
15 Article 35 of Public Act 96-956, as amended, is re-
16 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Court of
17 Claims for payment of line of duty awards."; and

18 on page 64, line 18 by changing "10,000,000" to "9,807,400";
19 and

20 by deleting lines 19 through 21 on page 64; and

1 by replacing "\$39,775,000" with "\$29,775,000" on line 10 of
2 page 65; and

3 by inserting below line 10 of page 65 the following:

4 "Section 35. The following named amount, or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended from an
6 appropriation hereto made for such purpose in Section 40 of
7 Article 35 of Public Act 96-956, as amended, is re-
8 appropriated to the Court of Claims for payment of claims as
9 follows:

10 For claims other than Crime Victims:

11 Payable from the General

12 Revenue Fund10,000,000"; and

13 on page 100, line 1 by changing "for which" to "regardless of
14 whether"; and

15 on page 100, immediately below line 9, by inserting the
16 following:

17 "Section 375. The following named amounts are
18 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Court of
19 Claims to pay claims in conformity with awards and

1 recommendations made by the Court of Claims as follows:

2 No. 04-CC-4021, Four Rivers Special
3 Education District, Breach of Contract,
4 against the State Board of Education\$45,047.80

5 No. 05-CC-1931, Michelle Del Valle, Personal
6 Injury, against the Department of
7 Transportation\$49,500.00

8 No. 11-CC-0625, Heartland Human Care Services,
9 Inc., Debt, against the Department of
10 Human Services\$396,900.30

11 No. 11-CC-2536, Aunt Martha's Youth Service
12 Center, Inc., Debt, against the
13 Department of Human Services\$122,774.00"; and

14 by replacing lines 19 through 20 on page 179 with the
15 following:

16 "Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect on
17 July 1, 2011, except that Article 0.5 and this Section take
18 effect upon becoming law."
