2 The jury list may be revised and amended annually in the discretion of the commissioners or jury administrator. Any 3 record kept by the jury commissioners or jury administrator for 4 5 over 4 years may be destroyed at their discretion. The name of each person on the list shall be entered in a book or books to 6 7 be kept for that purpose, and opposite the name shall be 8 entered his or her age and place of residence, giving street 9 and number, if any.

10 The Director of the Department of Employment Security shall 11 annually compile a list of persons who, in the prior 12 months, 12 filed a claim for unemployment insurance which shall be sent to 13 the Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts and the 14 Administrative Office of the Illinois Courts shall furnish that list to the jury administrator or jury commissioners, as 15 16 provided in Section 1a-1 of the Jury Act.
