The sum of \$125,000, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 12 13 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground 14 15 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Act.
- 16 Section 20. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Underground Utility 17 Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois Commerce 18 19 Commission for refunds.
- 20 Section 25. The sum of \$65,000,000, or so much thereof 21 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Wireless 22 Service Emergency Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission

1	for	its	administrative	costs	and	for	grants	to	emergency
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- 2 telephone system boards, qualified government entities, or
- 3 the Department of State Police for the design,
- 4 implementation, operation, maintenance, or upgrade of

13 Section 40. The sum of \$4,450,700, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 14 15 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 16 17 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for 18 19 administrative expenses.

Section 45. The sum of \$520,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for railroad crossing improvement initiatives.

- Section 50. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 1
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue 2
- Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for costs associated
- with administering the public utilities program.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 5
