A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1 The following named amounts, or so much  
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated  
7 to the Human Rights Commission for the objects and purposes  
8 hereinafter enumerated:

9 GENERAL OFFICE

10 Payable from General Revenue Fund:

11	For Personal Services .....	1,849,700
12	For State Contributions to Social Security .....	131,800
13	For Contractual Services .....	135,000
14	For Travel .....	6,500
15	For Commodities .....	10,000
16	For Printing .....	14,000
17	For Equipment .....	11,200
18	For Electronic Data Processing .....	7,000
19	For Telecommunications Services .....	<u>13,600</u>
20	Total	\$2,178,800

21 Section 5. The sum of \$600,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Human Rights  
2 Commission from the General Revenue Fund for expenses  
3 associated with the Illinois Torture Inquiry and Relief  
4 Commission.

5 Section 10. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Special  
7 Projects Division Fund to the Human Rights Commission for  
8 costs associated with processing and adjudicating cases under  
9 Equal Employment Opportunity Commission and U.S. Department  
10 of Housing and Urban Development contracts.

11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
12 2011.
