Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

5	Section 1 The following named sums, or so much thereof
6	as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and
7	purposes hereinafter named, are appropriated to meet the

22	may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
23	Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the
24	Adjutant General Division for a cash transfer to the Illinois

- of persons who are members of the Illinois National Guard or 2
- Illinois residents who are members of the armed forces. 3
- The sum of \$11,500,000, or so much thereof 4 Section 10.
- 5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support
- Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military 6
- Affairs Facilities Division for expenses related to Army 7
- 8 National Guard Facilities operations and maintenance
- 9 provided for in the Cooperative Funding Agreements, including
- 10 costs in prior years.
- Section 15. The sum of \$7,400, or so much thereof as may 11
- 12 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
- to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant 13
- 14 General Division for expenses related to the care
- 15 preservation of historic artifacts.
- Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as 16
- 17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs
- 18 Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of
- 19 the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other
- 20 programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be
- 21 made available from public or private sources.

- 1 Section 25. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military 2
- Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs 3
- 4 Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of
- grants to persons or families of persons who are members of 5
- 6 the Illinois National Guard or Illinois residents who are
- members of the armed forces of the United States and who have 7
- been called to active duty as a result of the September 11, 8
- 9 2001 terrorist attacks, including costs in prior years.
- 10 Section 30. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support 11
- 12 Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military
- 13 Affairs Facilities Division for expenses for operations and
- maintenance according to Joint-Use Agreement, including costs 14
- 15 in prior years.
- 16 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 2011. 17
