In the event of the receipt of funds from the Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention Council, through a grant 2 from the Criminal Justice Information Authority, the amount 3 of \$600,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 4 appropriated from the State Police Motor Vehicle Theft 5 6 Prevention Trust Fund to the Department of State Police for payment of expenses. 7
- 8 Section 45. The sum of \$8,250,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police 10 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Department of State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law 11 12 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State 13 Whistleblower Protection Act.
- 14 Section 50. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof 15 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police 16 Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the 17 18 Department of State Police.
- 19 Section 55. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police 21 Streetgang-Related Crime Fund to the Department of State 22 Police for operations related to streetgang-related Crime
