1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 3375 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 3375 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by 4 5 changing Section 16-118 as follows: 6 (40 ILCS 5/16-118) (from Ch. 108 1/2, par. 16-118) 7 Sec. 16-118. Retirement. "Retirement": Entry upon a retirement annuity or receipt of a single-sum retirement 8 benefit granted under this Article after termination of active 9 10 service as a teacher. 11 (a) An annuitant receiving a retirement annuity other than 12 a disability retirement annuity may accept employment as a 13 teacher from a school board or other employer specified in Section 16-106 without impairing retirement status, if that 14

employment: (1) is not within the school year during which

service was terminated; and (2) does not exceed 100 paid days

- or 500 paid hours in any school year (during the period
- 2 beginning July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2011, 120 paid days or
- 3 600 paid hours in each school year). Where such permitted
- 4 employment is partly on a daily and partly on an hourly basis,
- 5 a day shall be considered as 5 hours.
- 6 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to an annuitant who
- 7 returns to teaching under the program established in Section
- 8 16-150.1, for the duration of his or her participation in that
- 9 program.
- 10 (c) Subsection (a) shall not be construed to authorize
- 11 multiple annuitants, without impairing their retirement
- 12 status, to accept employment with a school district or other
- employer in order to fill, as a group, a teaching position that
- 14 would ordinarily be occupied by an active participant. Instead,
- if a school board or other employer determines that there is a
- subject or administrative position shortage that would require
- that action, then it must apply for an exemption under Section
- 18 <u>16-150.1.</u>
