- Section 5. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as 1 2 necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance Fund to the Teachers' Retirement System of the 3 Illinois for additional costs 4 of due 5 establishment of minimum retirement allowances pursuant to 6 Sections 16-136.2 and 16-136.3 of the Illinois Pension Code,
- Section 10. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Common School Fund to the Illinois Teachers' Retirement System for the employer contributions required by the State as an employer of teachers described under subsection (e) of Section 16-158 of the Illinois Pension Code.
- Section 15. The amount of \$10,449,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Public School Teachers' Pension and Retirement Fund of Chicago for the state's contribution for retirement contributions under Section 17-127 of the Illinois Pension Code for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2012.
