Section 50. The sum of \$1,295,000, or so much thereof as 17 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 19 20 for licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and 21 thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning 22 of such facilities and for identification, decontamination 23 and environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties 24

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2 Section 55. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 4 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 5 for the purpose of funding costs related to environmental 6 cleanup of the Ottawa Radiation Areas Superfund Project under 7 cooperative agreements with the Federal Government.

8 Section 60. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 10 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for recovery and remediation of radioactive materials and 11 12 contaminated facilities or properties when such expenses cannot be paid by a responsible person or an available 13 14 surety.

15 Section 65. The sum of \$757,000, or so much thereof as 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 17 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 18 for local responder training, demonstrations, research, 19 studies and investigations under funding agreements with the 20 Federal Government.

21 Section 70. The sum of \$97,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 2 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for related training and travel expenses 3 and to reimburse the Illinois State Police and the Illinois 4 Commerce Commission for costs incurred for activities related 5 6 to inspecting and escorting shipments of spent nuclear fuel, high-level radioactive waste, and transuranic waste 7 in Illinois as provided under the rules of the Agency. 8

9 Section 75. The sum of \$271,200, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Sheffield Agreed 11 Order Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency for 12 the care, maintenance, monitoring, testing, remediation and 13 insurance of the low-level radioactive waste disposal site 14 near Sheffield, Illinois.

The sum of \$990,000, or so much thereof as 15 Section 80. 16 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Low-Level Radioactive Waste Facility Development and Operation Fund to 17 18 Illinois Emergency Management Agency for the use in 19 accordance with Section 14(a) of the Illinois Low-Level 20 Radioactive Waste Management Act for costs related to 21 establishing a low-level radioactive waste disposal facility.

Section 85. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as

1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation 2 Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency 3 for ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois 4 Emergency Management Agency to include support of a

centralized administrative processing center.

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6 Section 90. The sum of \$686,000, or so much thereof as 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Nuclear Safety 8 Emergency Preparedness Fund to the Illinois Emergency 9 Management Agency for ordinary and contingent expenses of the 10 Illinois Emergency Management Agency to include support of a 11 centralized administrative processing center.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
 2012.

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
