1 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Interstate 57 is a major thoroughfare that runs 3 through the a large portion of the City of Chicago and the 4 outlying suburbs, as well as through the State of Illinois, 5 tracing the route of the former Illinois Central railroad line; 6 and 7 WHEREAS, The Tuskegee Airmen were dedicated, determined 8 young men who enlisted to become America's first black military 9 airmen; and 10 WHEREAS, Each of the men possessed a strong personal desire 11 to serve the United States with the best of his ability; and 12 WHEREAS, After the end of World War II, black airmen 13 returned to the United States and once again faced racism and hatred, despite their outstanding service record; and 14 15 WHEREAS, These brave men deserve to be recognized by the 16 State of Illinois for their service to their country during 17 wartime; therefore, be it 18 RESOLVED, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES THE 19 NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, THE SENATE CONCURRING HEREIN, that the section of Interstate 57

- 1 between Exit 339 at Sauk Trail Road, and Exit 353 at 127th
- 2 Street and Burr Oak Avenue, be renamed the Tuskegee Airmen
- 3 Memorial Highway; and be it further
- 4 RESOLVED, That the Illinois Department of Transportation
- 5 is requested to erect at suitable locations, consistent with
- 6 State and federal regulations, appropriate plaques or signs
- 7 giving notice of the name of the Tuskegee Airmen Memorial
- 8 Highway; and be it further
- 9 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- 10 presented to the Secretary of the Illinois Department of
- 11 Transportation.
