1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 839

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 839, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment No.  
4 2 as follows:

5 on page 1, line 6, by removing "3-600,"; and

6 on page 2, by deleting lines 20 through 25; and

7 on page 3, by deleting line 1; and

8 on page 4, by replacing lines 3 through 5 with the following:

9 "involuntary admission on an inpatient or outpatient basis, the  
10 court shall dismiss the petition and order the"; and

11 on page 4, by replacing lines 12 through 14 with the following:

12 "discharged or it may order another hearing. Unless the court  
13 orders the respondent held for temporary detention and

1 examination pursuant to Section 3-607 or the State's Attorney  
2 files notice with the court that a new petition will be  
3 prepared and filed within 24 hours and upon the State's  
4 Attorney's demonstration of good cause, the court may order the  
5 respondent held for 24 hours pending the filing of the new  
6 petition or a new petition was filed prior to the court's order  
7 of dismissal, there shall be no"; and

8 on page 4, line 17, by inserting after the period the  
9 following:

10 "If no petition is prepared and filed within 24 hours the  
11 respondent shall be immediately discharged, unless the  
12 respondent requests to remain at the facility as an informal or  
13 voluntary recipient."
