1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1743 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend Senate Bill 1743 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section 4 2-3.25q-5 as follows: 5 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.25q-5 new)7 Sec. 2-3.25q-5. Waivers with respect to certain districts. A school district that receives less than 15% of its total 8 revenue from this State (1) may choose to waive any mandate 9 10 placed on it by this Code or the State Board of Education's

administrative rules, with the exception of laws and rules

pertaining to special education, teacher certification,

teacher tenure, and seniority; Section 5-2.1 of this Code; and

compliance with the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001

(Public Law 107-110); or (2) on and after the applicable

implementation date, may not seek a waiver or seek a

- modification of a mandate regarding the requirements for (A) 1
- student performance data to be a significant factor in teacher 2
- or principal evaluations or (B) teachers and principals to be 3
- rated using the 4 categories of "excellent", "proficient", 4
- 5 "needs improvement", or "unsatisfactory".
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 6
- 2011.". 7
