Amend Senate Bill 1821, AS AMENDED, 3 with reference to page and line numbers of House Amendment No. 1 as follows: 4 5 on page 7, by replacing lines 6 through 17 with the following: 6 "(f) The Commission shall make its determination on any 7 application for a certificate of authority filed pursuant to this Section and issue its final order within 11 months after 8 the date that the application is filed. The Commission's 9 failure to act within this time period shall not be deemed an 10 11 approval or denial of the application. 12 (g) A final order of the Commission granting a certificate 13 of authority pursuant to this Act shall be conditioned upon the 14 applicant obtaining all required permits or approvals from the Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration of the 15

U.S. Department of Transportation, U.S. Army Corps

Engineers, and Illinois Department of Agriculture, in addition

- to all other permits and approvals necessary for the 1
- construction and operation of the pipeline prior to the start 2
- 3 of any construction. The final order must specifically prohibit
- the start of any construction until all such permits and 4
- 5 approvals have been obtained.".
