1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 2172

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 2172 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
5 changing Section 50-30 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 500/50-30)

7 Sec. 50-30. Revolving door prohibition.

8 (a) Chief procurement officers, State purchasing
9 officers, procurement compliance monitors, their designees
10 whose principal duties are directly related to State
11 procurement, and ~~and~~ executive officers confirmed by the Senate
12 are expressly prohibited for a period of 2 years after
13 terminating an affected position from engaging in any
14 procurement activity relating to the State agency most recently
15 employing them in an affected position for a period of at least
16 6 months. The prohibition includes but is not limited to:

1 lobbying the procurement process; specifying; bidding;
2 proposing bid, proposal, or contract documents; on their own
3 behalf or on behalf of any firm, partnership, association, or
4 corporation. This subsection applies only to persons who
5 terminate an affected position on or after January 15, 1999.

6 (b) In addition to any other provisions of this Code,
7 employment of former State employees is subject to the State
8 Officials and Employees Ethics Act.
