Amends the Election Code. Provides that each petition for nomination shall include an affidavit signed by the candidate, under oath, stating that the petition contains no fewer than the specified minimum number of signatures. Provides that the election authority with whom the petition for nomination would otherwise be filed may not accept for filing any petition for nomination that does not include the affidavit.

Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Sections
7-10.4, 8-8.2, and 10-5.2 as follows:

Each petition for nomination shall include an 8 9 affidavit signed by the candidate, under oath, stating that the petition contains no fewer than the minimum number of 10 signatures specified in Section 7-10. The State Board of 11 12 Elections and the various election authorities and local election officials with whom the petition for nomination would 13 14 otherwise be filed may not accept for filing any petition for nomination that does not include the affidavit required under 15 16 this Section.
