SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/45-62 new

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that, in awarding State contracts requiring the procurement of motor fuel, preference may be given to an otherwise qualified bidder or offeror who will fulfill the contract through the use of fuel produced at an Illinois renewable fuel plant, provided that the cost included in the bid of motor fuel produced at an Illinois renewable fuel plant is not more than 1% greater than the average cost of motor fuel not produced at an Illinois renewable fuel plant. Effective January 1, 2013.

4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by 5 adding Section 45-62 as follows:

7 Sec. 45-62. Illinois agricultural commodity-based fuel. In awarding contracts requiring the procurement of motor fuel, 8 9 preference may be given to an otherwise qualified bidder or 10 offeror who will fulfill the contract through the use of motor fuel produced at an Illinois renewable fuel plant, provided 11 12 that the cost included in the bid of motor fuel produced at an Illinois renewable fuel plant is not more than 1% greater than 13 14 the average cost of motor fuel not produced at an Illinois 15 renewable fuel plant. 16 For purposes of this Section: 17 "Motor fuel" has the same meaning as in Section 1.1 of the

18 Motor Fuel Tax Law.

21 "Renewable fuel" has the same meaning as in Section 10 of
