SENATE RESOLUTION

The members of the Illinois Senate wish to 2 WHEREAS, 3 recognize the 5th anniversary of the Smoke Free Illinois Act on 4 January 1, 2013, and to proclaim the month of January as Smoke 5 Free Illinois Month; and 6 WHEREAS, Secondhand smoke is a major health hazard and 7 there is no risk-free level of exposure to secondhand smoke; 8 approximately 50,000 deaths each year are attributable to 9 secondhand smoke exposure according to the U.S. Surgeon General, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and 10 11 the National Cancer Institute; and 12 Separate smoking areas, air cleaning, 13 ventilation does not eliminate exposure to secondhand smoke; smoke-free policies are the only effective protection from 14 exposure to secondhand smoke and smoke-free laws provide 15 immediate health benefits, most notably a decline in heart 16 17 attack hospitalizations; and 18 WHEREAS, Hospitalizations in Illinois for tobacco-related 19 diseases have declined since the Smoke Free Illinois Act was enacted; it is estimated that more than 35,000 heart disease 20 21 hospitalizations among Illinois residents have been prevented

because of the Smoke Free Illinois Act, resulting in an

- 1 estimated savings of \$1.8 billion in hospital costs alone,
- 2 according to Illinois Department of Health data; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The Smoke Free Illinois Act protects all residents
- 4 and visitors regardless of where they work or play and it
- 5 attracts visitors from states with little or no protection from
- 6 secondhand smoke; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The health and economic benefits of the Illinois
- 8 Smoke Free Act are widely recognized; therefore, be it
- 9 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETY-SEVENTH GENERAL
- 10 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we recognize the 5th
- 11 anniversary of the Smoke Free Illinois Act and proclaim the
- 12 month of January as Smoke Free Illinois Month to remind the
- 13 public about the benefits of protecting everyone from the
- 14 health risks associated with secondhand smoke and the
- importance of prohibiting smoking in all public places and
- workplaces; and be it further
- 17 RESOLVED, That a suitable copy of this resolution be
- presented to the Smoke Free Illinois Coalition as an expression
- of our esteem and respect.
