## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/11-1304.5

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that notwithstanding any provision, law, or rule to the contrary, a person who commits a violation of parking of a vehicle with expired registration for the first time shall be subject to fines, penalties, fees, and costs not to exceed \$25.

- 7 Sec. 11-1304.5. Parking of vehicle with expired
- 8 registration.
- 9 (a) No person may stop, park, or leave standing upon a
- 10 public street, highway, or roadway a vehicle upon which is
- 11 displayed an Illinois registration plate or plates or
- 12 registration sticker after the termination of the registration
- 13 period for which the registration plate or plates or
- 14 registration sticker was issued or after the expiration date
- 15 set under Section 3-414 or 3-414.1 of this Code.
- 16 (b) Notwithstanding any provision, law, or rule to the
- 17 contrary, a person who commits a violation of this Section for
- 18 the first time shall be subject to fines, penalties, fees, and
- costs not to exceed \$25.
