1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 997

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 997 as follows:

3 on page 17, by replacing lines 18 through 20 with the
4 following:

5 "(4) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
6 establishment that dispenses alcoholic beverages for
7 consumption on the premises, or any adjacent property or
8 parking lot area under control of or owned by the
9 establishment where carry is prohibited under this
10 Section."; and

11 on page 17, by replacing lines 25 through line 16 on page 18
12 with the following:

13 "(7) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
14 preschool, elementary school, or secondary school or any
15 portion of any school building thereof; or any school
16 property surrounding a preschool, elementary school, or

1 secondary school building, including but not limited to
2 sidewalks and parking lot areas adjacent to or near
3 preschool, elementary school, or secondary school
4 property.

5 (8) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
6 portion of a building used as a child care facility, or any
7 adjacent property or parking lot area under control of or
8 owned by a child care facility. Nothing in this Section
9 shall prevent the owner or operator of a child care
10 facility in a family home from owning or possessing a
11 firearm or license, so long as the firearm is stored
12 unloaded in a locked container.

13 (9) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
14 gaming facility or any adjacent property or parking lot
15 area under control of or owned by a gaming facility
16 licensed under the Riverboat Gambling Act or the Horse
17 Racing Act of 1975. No person may knowingly carry a firearm
18 into any licensed establishment, licensed truck stop
19 establishment, licensed fraternal establishment, or
20 licensed veterans establishment licensed under the Video
21 Gaming Act or any adjacent property or parking lot area
22 under the control of or owned by a licensed establishment,
23 licensed truck stop establishment, licensed fraternal
24 establishment, or licensed veterans establishment licensed
25 under the Video Gaming Act.

26 (10) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any

1 gated area of an amusement park, or any adjacent property
2 or parking lot area under control of or owned by an
3 amusement park.

4 (11) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
5 stadium, arena, or collegiate or professional sporting
6 event, or any adjacent property or parking lot area under
7 the control of or owned by a facility where carry is
8 prohibited under this Section.

9 (12) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
10 hospital or mental health facility, or onto any adjacent
11 property or parking lot area under the control of or owned
12 by a hospital or mental health facility."; and

13 on page 18, by replacing lines 23 through 26 with the
14 following:

15 "(14) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
16 library, or onto any adjacent property or parking lot area
17 under the control of or owned by a library."; and

18 on page 19, by inserting after line 5 the following:

19 "(17) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
20 organized public gathering, including street fairs,
21 festivals, farmer's markets, carnivals, concerts,
22 protests, parades, or other temporary special events,
23 conducted primarily outdoors on property open to the
24 public, and that requires the issuance of a permit from the

1 municipality or county where it occurs, unless the
2 municipality or county specifically authorizes persons to
3 carry concealed firearms at the event. The prohibitions in
4 this Section extend to any adjacent property or parking lot
5 area used in connection with a prohibited public gathering.
6 No person may knowingly carry a firearm at an organized
7 protest or rally with 10 or more persons located within 500
8 feet of a governmental building.

9 (18) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
10 church, temple, or other place of worship, and any adjacent
11 property or parking lot area owned by or under the control
12 of a church, temple, or other place of worship, unless
13 authorized to carry the firearm by the church, temple, or
14 other place of worship.

15 (19) No person may knowingly carry a firearm on buses,
16 trains, or any form of transportation paid for in part or
17 whole with public funds, and any transportation facility
18 and the surrounding premises under its control.

19 (20) No person may carry a firearm into a public park,
20 playground, or recreational area including parking lots of
21 the park, playground, or recreational area.

22 (21) No person may knowingly carry a firearm into any
23 public or private zoo or museum open to the public, or any
24 adjacent property or parking lot area under control of or
25 owned by the zoo or museum."; and

2 on page 20, by deleting lines 13 through 21.
