

## 98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2013 and 2014 HB1238

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.826 new 625 ILCS 5/3-699 new

Amends the State Finance Act. Creates the Committed to a Cure Fund. Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides for the issuance of The H Foundation - Committed to a Cure for Cancer plates. Sets the cost of issuance at \$40, \$25 of which will go to the Committed to a Cure Fund and \$15 of which will go to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, and \$27 for renewal, \$25 of which will go to the Committed to a Cure Fund and \$2 of which will go to the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that money in the Committed to a Cure Fund shall be distributed, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly, to the Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Cancer Center of Northwestern University for scientific research related to cancer.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding
- 5 Section 5.826 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/5.826 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 5.826. The Committed to a Cure Fund.</u>
- 8 Section 10. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
- 9 Section 3-699 as follows:
- 10 (625 ILCS 5/3-699 new)
- 11 Sec. 3-699. The H Foundation Committed to a Cure for
- 12 Cancer plates
- 13 (a) The Secretary, upon receipt of all applicable fees and
- applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may
- 15 issue special registration plates designated as The H
- 16 Foundation Committed to a Cure for Cancer license plates. The
- 17 special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only
- 18 to passenger vehicles of the first division or motor vehicles
- of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds.
- 20 Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the
- 21 multi-year procedure established by Section 3-414.1 of this

- 2 (b) The design and color of the special plates shall be 3 wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Appropriate 4 documentation, as determined by the Secretary, shall accompany 5 each application.
- 6 (c) An applicant for the special plate shall be charged a 7 \$40 fee for original issuance in addition to the appropriate registration fee. Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the 8 9 Committed to a Cure Fund and \$15 shall be deposited into the 10 Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund, to be used by 11 the Secretary to help defray the administrative processing 12 costs. For each registration renewal period, a \$27 fee, in addition to the appropriate registration fee, shall be charged. 13 14 Of this fee, \$25 shall be deposited into the Committed to a 15 Cure Fund and \$2 shall be deposited into the Secretary of State 16 Special License Plate Fund.
  - (d) The Committed to a Cure Fund is created as a special fund in the State treasury. All money in the Committed to a Cure Fund shall be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to the Robert H. Lurie Comprehensive Cancer Center of Northwestern University for the purpose of funding scientific research on cancer.
