## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/24-3A

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Makes a technicaal change in a Section concerning gunrunning.

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by changing
- 5 Section 24-3A as follows:
- 6 (720 ILCS 5/24-3A)
- 7 Sec. 24-3A. Gunrunning.
- 8 (a) A person commits gunrunning when when he or she
- 9 transfers 3 or more firearms in violation of any of the
- 10 paragraphs of Section 24-3 of this Code.
- 11 (b) Sentence. A person who commits gunrunning:
- 12 (1) is guilty of a Class 1 felony;
- 13 (2) is guilty of a Class X felony for which the 14 sentence shall be a term of imprisonment of not less than 8 15 years and not more than 40 years if the transfer is of not
- 16 less than 11 firearms and not more than 20 firearms;
- 17 (3) is guilty of a Class X felony for which the
- sentence shall be a term of imprisonment of not less than
- 19 10 years and not more than 50 years if the transfer is of
- 20 more than 20 firearms.
- 21 A person who commits gunrunning by transferring firearms to a
- 22 person who, at the time of the commission of the offense, is
- under 18 years of age is guilty of a Class X felony.
