SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 5/24-3A

Amends the Criminal Code of 2012. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning gunrunning.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning criminal law.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Criminal Code of 2012 is amended by changing
5 Section 24-3A as follows:

6 (720 ILCS 5/24-3A)

7 Sec. 24-3A. Gunrunning.

8 (a) A person commits gunrunning when ~~when~~ he or she
9 transfers 3 or more firearms in violation of any of the
10 paragraphs of Section 24-3 of this Code.

11 (b) Sentence. A person who commits gunrunning:

12 (1) is guilty of a Class 1 felony;

13 (2) is guilty of a Class X felony for which the
14 sentence shall be a term of imprisonment of not less than 8
15 years and not more than 40 years if the transfer is of not
16 less than 11 firearms and not more than 20 firearms;

17 (3) is guilty of a Class X felony for which the
18 sentence shall be a term of imprisonment of not less than
19 10 years and not more than 50 years if the transfer is of
20 more than 20 firearms.

21 A person who commits gunrunning by transferring firearms to a
22 person who, at the time of the commission of the offense, is
23 under 18 years of age is guilty of a Class X felony.
