- Sec. 40. Department requirements. Notwithstanding any 10
- 11 other provision of law, the Department shall require the
- 12 following:
- 13 (a) with respect to the Department's permit process for
- levee improvements, the Department shall provide notice of 14
- submissions and a detailed timeline for review the submitter 15
- 16 within 90 days;
- 17 (b) with respect to Department standards for construction
- 18 in rural areas, the Department shall permit a water surface
- 19 profile increase of 0.5 feet;
- 20 (c) with respect to Department standards for construction
- in urban areas, the Department shall permit a water surface 21
- 22 profile increase of 0.1 feet; and
- 2.3 (d) with respect to mitigation analysis, a mitigation
- analysis shall only be performed if a water surface profile 2.4

- 1 increase of 0.5 feet in rural areas, or of 0.1 in urban areas,
- 2 exceeds an induced head study.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 3
