1	AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2974
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend House Bill 2974 on page 1,
3	immediately below line 3, by inserting the following:
4	"Section 3. The Illinois Conservation Foundation Act is
5	amended by changing Section 15 as follows:
6	(20 ILCS 880/15)
7	Sec. 15. Organization, powers, and duties of Foundation. As
8	soon as practical after the Foundation is created, the Board of
9	Directors shall meet, organize, and designate, by majority
10	vote, a treasurer, secretary, and any additional officers that
11	may be needed to carry out the activities of the Foundation,
12	and shall adopt bylaws of the Foundation. The Department of
13	Natural Resources may adopt other rules deemed necessary to
14	govern Foundation procedures.
15	The Foundation may accept gifts or grants from the federal

16 government, its agencies or officers, or from any person, firm,

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1 or corporation, and may expend receipts on activities that it considers suitable to the performance of its duties under this 2 3 Act and consistent with any requirement of the grant, gift, or 4 bequest. Funds collected by the Foundation shall be considered 5 private funds, except those received from public entities, and 6 shall be held in an appropriate account outside of the State Treasury. Private funds collected by the Foundation are not 7 8 subject to the Public Funds Investment Act. The Foundation is exempt from the Accountability for the Investment of Public 9 10 Funds Act. Foundation procurement is exempt from the Illinois 11 Procurement Code when only private funds are used for procurement expenditures. The treasurer of the Foundation 12 13 shall be custodian of all Foundation funds. The Foundation's accounts and books shall be set up and maintained in a manner 14 15 approved by the Auditor General; and the Foundation and its 16 officers shall be responsible for the approval of recording of receipts, approval of payments, and the proper filing of 17 required reports. The Foundation may be assisted in carrying 18 out its functions by personnel of the Department of Natural 19 20 Resources. The Department shall provide reasonable assistance to the Foundation to achieve the purposes of the Foundation. 21 22 The Foundation shall cooperate fully with the boards, commissions, agencies, departments, and institutions of the 23 24 State. The funds held and made available by the Illinois 25 Conservation Foundation shall be subject to financial and 26 compliance audits by the Auditor General in compliance with the

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1	Illinois State Auditing Act.
2	The Foundation shall not have any power of eminent domain.

4	Section 4. The Accountability for the Investment of Public
5	Funds Act is amended by adding Section 12 as follows:
6	(30 ILCS 237/12 new)
7	Sec. 12. Exemptions. This Act does not apply to the
8	Illinois Conservation Foundation Act.".
