1 Commission shall address, at a minimum, all of the following: (1) Access to safe, decent and affordable housing. 2 3 (2) Access to adequate food and nutrition. 4 (3) Access to affordable and quality health care. 5 (4) Equal access to quality education and training. (5) Dependable and affordable transportation. 6 (6) Access to quality and affordable child care. 7 8 (7)Opportunities to engage in meaningful and 9 sustainable work that pays a living wage. 10 (8) The availability of adequate income supports. 11 The strategic plan shall include specific policy and fiscal

recommendations and a timeline for each stage of implementation 12 13 for each recommendation. For each recommendation, the 14 Commission shall identify in measurable terms the actual or 15 potential impact. The Commission may review and may make 16 comments and recommendations on existing or proposed programs, policies, administrative rules, and statutes that have an 17 18 impact on poverty in Illinois and, in particular, people living 19 in extreme poverty.
