SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/10

from Ch. 127, par. 146

Amends the State Finance Act. Provides that, when an appropriation has been made by the General Assembly for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the operation, maintenance, and administration of each of the State's public universities, the State Comptroller shall draw his or her warrant on the State Treasurer for the payment of the same upon the presentation of itemized vouchers, issued, certified, and approved by the president of that university (now, by the president and secretary of the Board of Trustees of the university, with the corporate seal of the university attached). Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by changing Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 105/10) (from Ch. 127, par. 146)
- 7 Sec. 10. When an appropriation has been made by the General Assembly for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the 8 9 operation, maintenance and administration of the several offices, departments, institutions, boards, commissions and 10 agencies of the State government, the State Comptroller shall 11 draw his warrant on the State Treasurer for the payment of the 12 13 same upon the presentation of itemized vouchers, issued, 14 certified, and approved, as follows:

- 1 Commission, to be certified and approved by its Chairman, 2 or when it is organized with Co-Chairmen, by either of its 3 Co-Chairmen;
 - (16) All other officers, boards, commissions and agencies of the State government, certified and approved by such officer or by the president or chairman and secretary or by the executive officer of such board, commission or agency;
 - (17) Individuals, to be certified by such individuals;
- 10 (18) The farmers' institute, agricultural, livestock,
 11 poultry, scientific, benevolent, and other private
 12 associations, or corporations of whatsoever nature, to be
 13 certified and approved by the president and secretary of
 14 such society.
- Nothing contained in this Section shall be construed to amend or modify the "Personnel Code".
- 17 This Section is subject to Section 9.02.

- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 20 becoming law.
