1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
24-5 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/24-5) (from Ch. 122, par. 24-5)

7 Sec. 24-5. Physical fitness and professional growth.

8 <u>(a) In this Section, "employee" means any employee of a</u> 9 <u>school district, a student teacher, an employee of a contractor</u> 10 <u>that provides services to students or in schools, or any other</u> 11 <u>individual subject to the requirements of Section 10-21.9 or</u> 12 34-18.5 of this Code.

(b) School boards shall require of new employees evidence 13 14 of physical fitness to perform duties assigned and freedom from communicable disease, including tuberculosis. Such evidence 15 16 shall consist of a physical examination and a tuberculin skin 17 test and, if appropriate, an x ray, made by a physician licensed in Illinois or any other state to practice medicine 18 19 and surgery in all its branches, an advanced practice nurse who 20 has a written collaborative agreement with a collaborating 21 physician that authorizes the advanced practice nurse to 22 perform health examinations, or a physician assistant who has been delegated the authority to perform health examinations by 23

his or her supervising physician not more than 90 days 1 2 preceding time of presentation to the board, and the cost of 3 such examination shall rest with the employee. A new or existing employee may be subject to additional health 4 5 examinations, including screening for tuberculosis, as required by rules adopted by the Department of Public Health or 6 7 by order of a local public health official. The board may from 8 time to time require an examination of any employee by a 9 physician licensed in Illinois to practice medicine and surgery 10 in all its branches, an advanced practice nurse who has a 11 written collaborative agreement with a collaborating physician 12 that authorizes the advanced practice nurse to perform health examinations, or a physician assistant who has been delegated 13 14 the authority to perform health examinations by his or her 15 supervising physician and shall pay the expenses thereof from 16 school funds.

17 <u>(c)</u> School boards may require teachers in their employ to 18 furnish from time to time evidence of continued professional 19 growth.
