## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

225 ILCS 85/8

from Ch. 111, par. 4128

Amends the Pharmacy Practice Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning licensure without examination.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Pharmacy Practice Act is amended by changing

  Section 8 as follows:
- 6 (225 ILCS 85/8) (from Ch. 111, par. 4128)
- 7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on January 1, 2018)
- 10 without examination, on payment of the required fee, an
- 11 applicant who is so licensed under the laws of another U.S.
- 12 jurisdiction or another country, if the requirements for
- licensure in the other jurisdiction in which the applicant was
- licensed, were, at the date of his or her licensure deemed by
- 15 the Board to be substantially equivalent to the requirements
- then in force in this State.
- A person holding an active, unencumbered license in good
- 18 standing in another jurisdiction who applies for a license
- 19 pursuant to Section 7 of this Act due to a natural disaster or
- 20 catastrophic event in another jurisdiction may be temporarily
- 21 authorized by the Secretary to practice pharmacy pending the
- 22 issuance of the license. This temporary authorization shall
- 23 expire upon issuance of the license or upon notification that

- 1 the Department has denied licensure.
- 2 Upon a declared Executive Order due to an emergency caused
- 3 by a natural or manmade disaster or any other exceptional
- 4 situation that causes an extraordinary demand for pharmacist
- 5 services, the Department may issue a pharmacist who holds a
- 6 license to practice pharmacy in another state an emergency
- 7 license to practice in this State.
