13	devices shall possess a valid sport fish	ing license.

1	Sec. 10-47. Taking of fish by casting net or shad scoop for	
2	use as bait. The following fish species may be taken with a	
3	casting net or shad scoop and used for bait on the body of	
4	water where they are collected if they are killed immediately:	
5	bighead carp (Hypophthalmichthys nobilis), black carp	
6	(Mylopharyngodon piceus), grass carp (Ctenopharyngodon	
7	idella), and silver carp (Hypophthalmichthys molotrix). The	
8	following fish species may be taken with a casting net or shad	
9	scoop and used for live or dead bait on the body of water where	
10	they are collected: mooneye (Hiodon tergisus), goldeye (Hiodon	
11	alosoides), skipjack herring (Alosa chrysochloris), carp	
12	(other than bighead carp (Hypophthalmichthys nobilis), black	
13	carp (Mylopharyngodon piceus), grass carp (Ctenopharyngodon	
14	idella), and silver carp (Hypophthalmichthys molotrix)), and	
15	any other fish listed in Section 10-110 of this Code. Any	
16	person using casting nets or a shad scoop for the taking of	
17	fish under this Section must possess a valid sport fishing	
18	license.".
