(b) For the purposes of this Act:

5 "Constitutional officer" means the Governor, Lieutenant
6 Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State, Comptroller,
7 and Treasurer.

8 "State agency" means all officers, boards, commissions, 9 and agencies of the executive, legislative, or judicial branch, 10 including, but not limited to, the Historic Preservation 11 Agency, the Architect of the Capitol, and the Department of 12 Natural Resources.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.".
