Amends the Trustees of Schools Article of the School Code. Provides that the trustees of schools' power to sue is subject to the prior approval of two-thirds of those school boards whose school districts are subject to the jurisdiction and authority of the trustees of schools. Effective immediately.

AN ACT concerning education.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
5 5-2 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/5-2) (from Ch. 122, par. 5-2)

7 Sec. 5-2. Governing board. The school business of all 8 school townships having school trustees shall be transacted by 9 three trustees, to be elected by the qualified voters of the township, as hereinafter provided. The trustees shall be a body 10 politic and corporate, by the name of "trustees of schools of 11 township No., range No.," according to the number, or 12 13 in case of school townships created from two or more 14 congressional townships, such name shall be "trustees of township county, Illinois." Such corporation shall have 15 16 perpetual existence, with power to sue and be sued, and to 17 plead and be impleaded, in all courts and places where judicial proceedings are had. However, the power to sue is subject to 18 19 the prior approval of two-thirds of those school boards whose 20 school districts are subject to the jurisdiction and authority 21 of the particular trustees of schools.
