SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

35 ILCS 5/247 new

Amends the Illinois Income Tax Act. Provides that, whenever a taxpayer is required to create or retain a specified number of jobs in order to receive an income tax or withholding credit, that taxpayer shall report certain employment data to the Department of Employment Security, and the Department shall post the information on its website.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Income Tax Act is amended by adding Section 247 as follows:
- 6 (35 ILCS 5/247 new)
- 7 Sec. 247. Verification of employment data. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, whenever a taxpayer is required to 8 create or retain a specified number of jobs in order to receive a credit against either the tax imposed by subsections (a) and 10 (b) of Section 201 or withholding payments due under Section 11 12 704A, including, but not limited to credits awarded under the Economic Development for a Growing Economy Tax Credit Act, 13 14 then, no later than 60 days after the last day of the taxable year in which the taxpayer receives the credit, the taxpayer 15 16 shall report to the Department of Employment Security the total 17 number of jobs actually created and retained during the previous taxable year as well as the job title of each position 18 19 created or retained and the total payroll attributable to those 20 positions. The Department of Employment Security shall post 21 this information on its website.
