1 Section 45. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court 3 Special Purposes Fund to the Supreme Court for the oversight 4 and management of electronic filing, case management systems, 5 and committees and commissions of the Supreme Court.

6 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
