1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1618

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 1618 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Abused and Neglected Child Reporting Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 4.03 as follows:

6 (325 ILCS 5/4.03 new)

7 Sec. 4.03. Reporting acts of sexual abuse against a minor.

8 (a) For the purposes of this Section:

9 "Minor" means any person under the age of 18.

10 "Sexual abuse" means criminal sexual assault,  
11 aggravated criminal sexual assault, predatory criminal  
12 sexual assault of a child, criminal sexual abuse,  
13 aggravated criminal sexual abuse, or sexual exploitation  
14 of a child as defined in subsection (a-5) of Section 11-9.1  
15 of the Criminal Code of 2012.

16 (b) Any person over the age of 18 who witnesses the

1 commission of an act that he or she reasonably believes to be  
2 an act of sexual abuse against a minor and who willfully fails  
3 to report the act to local law enforcement is guilty of a Class  
4 A misdemeanor for a first violation and a Class 4 felony for a  
5 second or subsequent violation."
