(b) A firefighter who is elected to the Illinois General 1 2 Assembly shall, upon written application to the employer, be 3 granted a leave of absence without compensation during his or 4 her term of office. 5 (c) A police officer or Sheriff's deputy may be a candidate 6 for or appointed to serve in, and if elected or appointed serve in, the Illinois General Assembly. A police officer or 7 Sheriff's deputy who is elected to the General Assembly shall, 8 9 upon written application to the employer, be granted a leave of 10 absence without compensation during his or her term of office. As long as the police officer or Sheriff's deputy is not in 11 uniform and not on duty, he or she may solicit votes and 12 13 campaign funds and challenge voters for the General Assembly 14 office for which he or she is a candidate.
