1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1724

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1724, AS AMENDED,
3 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the
4 following:

5 "Section 5. The Mental Health and Developmental
6 Disabilities Code is amended by changing Section 3-611 as
7 follows:

8 (405 ILCS 5/3-611) (from Ch. 91 1/2, par. 3-611)

9 Sec. 3-611. Within 24 hours, excluding Saturdays, Sundays
10 and holidays, after the respondent's admission under this
11 Article, the facility director of the facility shall file 2
12 copies of the petition, the first certificate, and proof of
13 service of the petition and statement of rights upon the
14 respondent with the court in the county in which the facility
15 is located. Upon completion of the second certificate, the
16 facility director shall promptly file it with the court and

1 provide a copy to the respondent. The facility director shall
2 make copies of the certificates available to the attorneys for
3 the parties upon request. Upon the filing of the petition and
4 first certificate, the court shall set a hearing to be held
5 within 5 days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, after
6 receipt of the petition. The court shall direct that notice of
7 the time and place of the hearing be served upon the
8 respondent, his responsible relatives, and the persons
9 entitled to receive a copy of the petition pursuant to Section
10 3-609.
